**A RESOLUTION OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL
AMENDING THE CONSOLIDATED FEE SCHEDULE**

WHEREAS, the Draper City Council wishes to amend the Consolidated Fee Schedule to be current; and,

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Fee Schedule needs to be updated to reflect new policy recently passed by Ordinance and Resolution

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the City to protect City owned assets as well as recoup actual costs of staff time and resources; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to establish fair and equal policies and fees for privately operated special events and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to accept donations for the overall development of Corner Canyon and surrounding area trails,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires the alarm fees to be consistent with finance needs and current billing procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approval. The City Council hereby amends the Consolidated Fee Schedule in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, part, or provision of this Resolution is held invalid, or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution, and all sections, parts, and provisions of this Resolution shall be severable..

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.



16. **EQUESTRIAN ANDY BALLARD ARENA RESERVATIONS**

- A) Arena Reservation Fee (Events charging no admission)
- (i) Day Show – 9 am – 10 pm ----- \$200.00 plus \$100.00 clean-up deposit
(\$10.00 non refundable) (Res 01-05)(Res 12-12)
 - (ii) Daily charge for use of arena lights ----- \$15.00
(Res. 02-30) (Res 12-12)
- B) Groups Charging an Admission Fee ----- \$300.00 per day plus \$100.00 clean-up deposit
(Res. 02-30)(Res. 12-12)
- C) Arena Reservation Fee - Draper City Residents All Youth/Adults Equestrian Groups (Res. 12-12)
(less than 4 hours) ----- No Charge
- D) Arena Reservation Fee – Non-Draper City Residents Youth/Adult (Res. 12-12)
(less than four hours)-----\$20 per hour
- E) Kitchen Rental (per day) ----- \$100.00

25. PARK AND RECREATION AND PAVILLION USER FEES

- H) Special Event Application Review and Permit Fee ----- \$50.00
- (i) Late Notification Fee----- \$40.00
- I) Filming Event Application Review and Permit Fee
- (i) Fee covers three (3) site locations----- \$100.00
 - (ii) Fee for additional locations, per three (3) locations----- \$100.00
- J) City Support Services Fee
- (i) Parks technician (per hour with two hour minimum) ----- \$26.40
 - (ii) Parks manager (per hour with two hour minimum) ----- \$46.75
- K) Voluntary Bike Permit Donation Fee
- (i) Draper Resident permit----- \$20.00
 - (ii) Non Resident permit----- \$30.00

3. **ALARM SERVICES**

(Ord No. 344) (Revised per Ord. No. 850) (Revised per Res. 10-47)

- A) Alarm User Permit ----- \$25.00 Annually

False alarm fees are assessed after two false alarms occur in a calendar year. This applies to residents, small businesses, and large commercial and financial institutions. (Res 04-38) (Amended per Res 08-41)

B) False Alarm Fees. *(Res 04-38) (Amended per Res 08-41)*

- (i) Responding to two false alarms ----- No Charge
- (ii) Third false alarm ----- \$55.00 per responding unit
- (iii) Fourth false alarm ----- \$80.00 per responding unit
- (iv) In excess of four alarms----- \$105.00 per responding unit

C) Late Fees - fees are due on the date the notice is issued by the City: *(Res. 02-35) (Amended per Res 06-54) (Amended per Res 08-41)*

- (i) Fees not paid within sixty (60) days have a penalty of 50% on the total unpaid balance including any unpaid late fees.
- (ii) Fees plus penalties not paid within ninety (90) days will be sent for collection for all penalties, costs and attorney's fees.

D) Interest Fees – are assessed on any unpaid obligations due Draper City with an outstanding balance in excess of 30 days from the date of the invoice at a rate of 18% annually or 1.5% per month. *(Res 08-41)*
