

RESOLUTION NO. 16-50

A RESOLUTION OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL FILLING A MIDTERM VACANCY AND APPOINTING A MEMBER OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL BOARD FOR THE TRAVERSE RIDGE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. (UCA) Section 17-D-1-301 *et seq.* Draper City has, by Ordinance No. 1124 and Draper City Municipal Code (DCMC) Section 3-1-290, created an administrative control board and delegated certain powers thereto to administer the responsibilities of the Traverse Ridge Special Service District; and

WHEREAS, DCMC Section 3-1-290(e) requires the Administrative Control Board be comprised of five members appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the City Council, and that each member shall be a registered voter within the special service district or be an officer or employee of Draper City; and

WHEREAS, Edan Jorgensen, who was appointed on May 26, 2015 as a member of the Administrative Control Board, is vacating the two-year appointed position; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to UCA Section 20A-1-512 the City prepared a notice of vacancy for the vacant board member position, posted the notice in four public places within the local district at least two weeks before the deadline for accepting nominees for appointment, published the notice in a newspaper of general circulation, and otherwise complied with all requirements of law for filling midterm vacancies; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy on the Administrative Control Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

The following registered voter of the Traverse Ridge Special Service District or officers or employees of Draper City shall be and is hereby appointed to fill a vacant two year term:


