

**RESOLUTION 17-44**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL  
DESIGNATING EMERGENCY INTERIM SUCCESSORS FOR THE  
CITY'S LEGISLATIVE AND ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY**

**WHEREAS** Utah Code 53-2a-807(1) designates emergency interim successors for the legislative and administrative authority.

**WHEREAS** Draper City wants to ensure the continuity of operations for all City departments during an emergency or disaster when supervisors or directors are not able to execute the duties of their position.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Draper City Council as follows:

**Section 1. Designation of Interim Emergency Successors.**

If the Mayor is unable to execute the duties of the office, the line of Legislative Emergency Interim Successor is: Mayor Pro-Tempore, Quorum of City Council Members, City Manager.


If the City Manager is unable to execute the duties of the office, the line of Administrative Emergency Interim Successors is: Assistant City Manager, Public Works Director, and Community Development Director.

**Section 2. Severability Clause.** If any part or provision of this Resolution is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution and all provisions, clauses and words of this Resolution shall be severable.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
