**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING DRAPER CITY POLICY
FOR DEAF CHILD SIGNS**

WHEREAS, as a municipality, Draper City is authorized to install and maintain various road signs as conditions require, pursuant to the broad authority granted by the Utah Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approval. The City Council hereby officially approves Resolution No. 17-66, adopting the Draper City Policy for Deaf Child Signs, attached hereto as Exhibit A.



Draper City Policy for Installation of Deaf Child Signs

PURPOSE

To provide a policy governing the installation of "Deaf Child" signs.

1.0 Criteria

- 1.1 A child must be certified as legally deaf. The certification must be by a qualified specialist. Documentation indicating the child is legally deaf must be submitted to the City.
- 1.2 A child must be between the ages of two (2) and eighteen (18) years of age at the time of the sign request.

2.0 Installation Limits

- 2.1 The signs will be installed only on a residential street with a posted speed of 25MPH or less. Deaf Child signs will not be allowed on streets classified as collector or arterial streets.
- 2.2 The signs will be installed at a minimum of 100 feet away from the property lines of the parent or guardian who is responsible for the deaf child. If the minimum distance places the sign within the adjacent property owner's frontage it will be placed at the property line. In these situations the placement of the "Deaf Child" signs will be reviewed and approved on a case by case basis.

3.0 Proof of Residency

- 3.1 Proof of residency (a copy of the property tax notice or utility billing) must be provided to the Public Works Operations Division, 72 E. Sigovah Court, Draper, Utah 84020, at the time the sign request is made and on a yearly basis thereafter.
- 3.2 If verification is not received, a personal contact will be made. If contact cannot be made, the sign will be removed.
- 3.3 The signs will be removed when the child reaches 18 years of age.

4.0 Application

- 4.1 Individuals requesting a Deaf Child sign shall submit the following to Public Works Operation Division (address above) for installation of the sign:
 - a. Letter requesting installation of the sign.
 - b. Documentation indicating child is legally deaf.
 - c. Proof of residency-tax notice or utility billing.
