

RESOLUTION NO. 13-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE CONSOLIDATED FEE SCHEDULE REGARDING THE STORM WATER UTILITY FEE

WHEREAS, the Chapter 8-5 of the Draper City Municipal Code establishes the storm sewer utility and provides in Section 8-5-070 that storm sewer water fee rates and charges shall be imposed against each parcel of real property within the City to fund the administration, planning, design, construction, water quality programming, operation, maintenance and repair of existing and future storm water facilities; and

WHEREAS, subsection (c) provides that service fees shall be set forth in Draper City's "Consolidated Fee Schedule" and may be differentiated according to the following classifications:

- (1) Residential parcels;
- (2) Undeveloped parcels;
- (3) Other parcels;
- (4) Credit for on-parcel mitigation;

WHEREAS, the storm drainage plan has identified millions of dollars in needed storm drain improvements for which no funding presently exists; and

WHEREAS, the storm water utility fee was last amended by Resolution 05-44; and

WHEREAS, this council finds it necessary and reasonable to increase the storm sewer utility fee by \$.50 per ERU (equivalent residential unit) per month per year for ten years;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Draper, State of Utah, as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. The Storm Water Utility Fee in the Draper City Consolidated Fee Schedule is hereby amended to read:

39. STORM WATER UTILITY FEE

- A) Residential or Commercial -
 - \$5.00 per ERU per month, effective July 1, 2013
 - \$6.00 per ERU per month, effective July 1, 2014
 - \$7.00 per ERU per month, effective July 1, 2015
 - \$8.00 per ERU per month, effective July 1, 2016
 - \$9.00 per ERU per month, effective July 1, 2017

- B) Interest charged on unpaid obligations due Draper City not paid within 30 days from the date of invoice: 18% on unpaid balance or 1-1/2% per month, minimum fee is \$2.00 per month.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, part or provision of this Resolution is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution. All sections, parts and provisions of this Resolution shall be severable.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
