Here are the fireworks safety tips you need to have to stay safe this summer:

“Keep pets away from fireworks”

- Never let children play with or ignite fireworks
- Always have an adult supervise fireworks activities
 - Keep pets away from fireworks
 - Wear safety glasses if you plan to light the fireworks
- Never throw fireworks at people or animals
- Obey all Draper fireworks laws
- Never use fireworks around potentially flammable material
- Keep a bucket of water handy in case of emergency
- Use fireworks outdoors, **never** indoors
