

RESOLUTION NO. 19-45

**A RESOLUTION OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL AMENDING
CITY COUNCIL MEETING RULES AND PROCEDURES
PERTAINING TO VOTING ON MOTIONS**

WHEREAS, Utah Code Ann. §10-3-606 requires a municipal legislative body to adopt rules of order and procedure to govern a public meeting of the legislative body; and

WHEREAS, Draper City Municipal Code 2-1-040 states meetings of the city council shall be governed by the rules and procedures adopted by the city council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Draper City Council has adopted by Resolution 14-54 “Meeting Rules and Procedures of the City Council of the City of Draper” (“Meeting Rules”) as its rules of order and procedure to govern its public meetings; and

WHEREAS, as per Rule 2.1, the Meeting Rules are in effect until such time as they are amended by the city council; and

WHEREAS, the Draper City Council desires to amend Rule 6.8 of its Meeting Rules to address the issue of voting on motions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Approval. The City Council hereby amends Rule 6.8 of its Meeting Rules as shown in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, part, or provision of this Resolution is held invalid, or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution, and all sections, parts, and provisions of this Resolution shall be severable..

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.



EXHIBIT A

6.8 Call for Vote: The Mayor shall call for a roll call vote on all issues voted on by the City Council. Council Members who are in attendance at the meeting when the vote is called shall vote for or against every issue put to a vote before the City Council. A Council Member shall not abstain or recuse themselves from any vote unless they have declared a conflict of interest, with a specifically stated and verified reason, pursuant to Draper City Municipal Code 19-2-010. The Mayor shall announce the result of the vote.
