

RESOLUTION NO. 13-46

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE FY2014 UTAH STATE ASSET FORFEITURE GRANT (SAFG) AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,511 TO BE USED FOR ALCOHOL AND DRUG EDUCATION/PREVENTION PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, Draper City Police Department was eligible to apply for FY-2014 Utah State Asset Forfeiture Grant (SAFG) funds based on our participation and submittal of seized asset forfeitures to the Utah Criminal Forfeiture Restricted Account (CFRA); and

WHEREAS, these funds will assist our efforts to continue to provide the D.A.R.E. program to elementary students, and teen drug/alcohol prevention presentations to middle and high school students; and

WHEREAS, with the addition of Draper's new schools (Corner Canyon High School and Crescent View Middle School), there will be more opportunity for our involvement in drug/alcohol, gang and crime prevention education, which is one purpose area SAFG award monies may be used; and

WHEREAS, we offer presentations and programs throughout the school year for the purpose of reducing youth drug/alcohol use, and to educate students and parents on the harmful effects and consequences regarding drug/alcohol use, peer pressure, bullying, texting and driving, teen drinking and driving, and making poor choices; and

WHEREAS, we work closely with the Canyons School District and Drug Free Draper Coalition in the coordination and implementation of these programs; and

WHEREAS, all CCJJ grants are based on the reimbursement of actual costs and there is no cash match required. This SAFG grant will be active from July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City is hereby authorized to accept the grant in the amount of \$4,511 from the State of Utah CCJJ to be used for Alcohol and Drug Education/Prevention Programs.

Section 2. This SAFG grant will be active from July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. There is no cash match required from the City.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, part, or provision of this Resolution is held invalid, or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution, and all sections, parts, and provisions of this Resolution shall be severable.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
