



- ALL applications will be subject to a five (5) day waiting period after application has been submitted.
- Applicant is required to consult with the utility companies, within the project area, prior to the start of the encroachment. In granting this permit to encroach upon Draper City Property and/or its Public Rights of Way, the City of Draper makes no representation as to the location of utility facilities within the work area, or the effect of the permitted encroachment on the said utilities. In addition, no authorization is given or inferred by this permit to allow access onto private property. Owner's written permission is required to be attached to the permit application, if a work plan includes access onto private property, including private lanes.
- In consideration for the granting of an encroachment permit by the City of Draper, the above noted applicant hereby promises (1) to perform the encroachment in a professional manner, in conformance with the ordinances of the City of Draper (<a href="www.draper.ut.us">www.draper.ut.us</a>) and (2) to hold harmless the City of Draper, its officers, agents, employees or servants from all other costs, damages and liabilities that may accrue or be claimed to accrue by reason of any work performed under a permit issued, pursuant to this application.
  - 24 HOUR ADVANCE NOTICE REQUIRED •
- CONTRACTOR MUST NOTIFY INSPECTOR WHEN WORK IS TO BE STARTED, WHEN WORK IS COMPLETED AND WHEN MATERIALS ARE TO BE INSTALLED

# DRAPER CITY ENCROACHMENT PERMIT-WORK AREA AND BMP MAP EXAMPLE


All BMPs in this example are for guidance only. Equivalent BMPs are acceptable per inspector's approval.




Best Management Practices (BMP)\*

- Install inlet protection down stream of project area to prevent sediment from being washed into storm drain system or other water body.
- Sweep/pick up all construction debris off road, and dispose of daily and after project completion.

\*Applicant is responsible to identify and install any additional or needed BMPs in order to prevent pollution from entering the storm drain system or other water body.





# **EXCAVATION ASPHALT PAVEMENT**

# EXCAVATION GENERAL NOTES

- 1. UNTREATED BASE COURSE: PROVIDE MATERIAL SPECIFIED IN SECTION 02230. PLACE AND COMPACT PER SECTION 02240 AND SECTION 02575. MAXIMUM LIFT THICKNESS IS 8-INCHES BEFORE COMPACTION.
- 2. SHORING: SHORE IN CONFORMANCE WITH SECTION 02214.
- 3. TACK COAT: FULL TACK COAT COVERAGE ON ALL VERTICAL SURFACES.
- 4. ASPHALT PAVEMENT: USE ASPHALT CONCRETE SPECIFIED IN SECTION 02513.

  A. COMPACT EACH LIFT IN CONFORMANCE WITH SECTION 02503

  B. PLANE OFF SURFACE DISTORTIONS THAT EXCEED 1/4 INCH DEVIATION IN 10 FEET.

  COAT PLANED SURFACES WITH A CATIONIC OR ANIONIC EMULSION AS APPROVED BY CITY ENGINEER.

  C. ASPHALT PAVEMENT THICKNESS DEPTH SHALL EQUAL EXISTING PLUS 1—INCH, 4" MINIMUM, 6" MAXIMUM D. MATCH EXISTING ASPHALT GRADATION ½ OR ¾.
- 5. JOINT REPAIR: IF A CRACK OCCURS AT THE "T" PATCH CONNECTION TO EXISTING PAVEMENT OR AT ANY STREET FIXTURE, SEAL THE CRACK PER SECTION 02511.
- 6. EQUIPMENT: ALL ASPHALT PAVEMENT SHALL BE INSTALLED WITH MECHANICAL PAVING EQUIPMENT UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY THE CITY ENGINEER.
- 7. COMPLY WITH ALL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 02575.
- 8. PLANT MIX SEAL COAT: FOR PLANT MIX SEAL COAT COMPLY WITH UDOT SPECIFICATION, SECTION 02786. MILL AND REPLACE EXISTING PLANT MIX SEAL COAT 10 FEET FROM EDGE OF SECOND CUT IN ALL DIRECTIONS.
