**MAYOR'S EXERCISE OF EMERGENCY POWER  
RELATED TO  
PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY  
DATED MARCH 12, 2020**


On March 12, 2020, pursuant to his authority under Utah Code Section 53-2a-208(1)(a), the Mayor of Draper City declared a local emergency due to the global outbreak of COVID-19 and the consequential risks to the health, safety, and welfare of Draper City residents.

Utah Code Section 53-2a-205 authorizes the Mayor of Draper City to utilize all available resources of the City as reasonably necessary to manage a state of emergency or local emergency and employ measures and give direction to City officers and which are reasonable and necessary for the purpose of securing compliance with the provisions of Section 205 and with orders, rules, and regulations made under Section 205.

The Mayor of Draper City therefore exercises the following emergency powers, effective immediately and throughout the Term as defined below:

1. Personnel Policies. The Draper City Manager is hereby authorized to promulgate temporary personnel policies to address personnel issues created as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, including, but not limited to, authorizing paid leave.
2. Term. This proclamation shall take effect immediately and will be ongoing for as long as the Proclamation of Local Emergency is in effect, unless this proclamation is amended or rescinded by the Mayor.
3. Filing. This proclamation shall be filed promptly with the office of the city recorder.
