STOP BEING VICTIM TO ANNOYING SCAM CALLS



If you're anything like me, you get at least one scam call a day. Typically it's pretty obvious they're people trying to fool you and get your personal information. Even still, the calls are aggravating.

So the question stands, how do you stop them? The first thing you can do is

probably the most obvious. Don't answer the phone — specifically if the call is from a number you don't recognize.

“Get a smartphone app that stops spam calls...”

The suggestion you'll hear the most is to put yourself on the Do Not Call Registry. The common

misconception is that putting yourself on the list will stop unwanted calls.

Unfortunately, it won't. It only gives you the option to “unsubscribe” from *legal* telemarketing and cold calls.

Last but not least, get a smartphone app that stops spam calls. There are dozens out there. Test some out and see which works best for you!

And remember, never give your personal information to strangers.
