

ORDINANCE NO. 1065

A DRAPER CITY ORDINANCE AMENDING DRAPER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2-6-060 REGARDING OFFICIAL BONDS

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary and appropriate to amend sections to the Draper City Municipal Code to clearly reflect the processes of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it is in the best interest of Draper City and the general health, safety and welfare of the public that these changes to Chapter 3 of the Municipal Code should be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Amendment. Draper City Municipal Code Section 2-6-060 is hereby amended to read:

Section 2-6-060 Official Bonds.

(a) Required. ~~Before commencing his or her duties, elected and appointed officers and employees of the~~ The City shall execute a corporate surety bond or have a blanket bond with good and sufficient sureties payable to Draper ~~city~~ City ~~conditioned~~ for the faithful performance of the duties of elected, appointed officers and employees ~~his or her office and the payment of all monies received by such officer according to the law~~ as required by state laws and the ordinances of Draper City. ~~in an amount as set forth by Resolution of the City Council.~~

(b) Limitation on Treasurer's Bond. The City Treasurer's bond may not be set at an amount less than that established by the State Money Management Council pursuant to Utah Code Ann. 51-7-15, as amended.

(c) Filed. All oaths and bonds of city officers shall be filed with the City Recorder, except the bond of the City Recorder's bond which shall be filed with the City Treasurer.

(d) Approval of Bonds. The bonds of Council Members shall be approved by the Mayor, and the bond of the Mayor shall be approved by the City Council, at the first meeting of the City Council in January following a municipal election.

(e) Premium Charge. The premium charged by for a any required corporate surety or blanket bond for any an elected, ~~or~~ appointed official officer, or employee of the City bond shall be paid by Draper City.

(f) Additional Bonds. The City Council may at any time require ~~further and~~ additional bonds or increased bond amounts of any or all elected officers, ~~or~~ appointed officers or employees of the

City by resolution or ordinance. Bond amounts may exceed those established by the State Money Management Council pursuant to Utah Code Ann. 51-7-15, as amended.

SECTION II. General Repealer. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION III. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon recording by the City Recorder, and 20 days after publication or posting or 30 days after final passage by the City Council, whichever is sooner.


