- MUST be a resident of Draper City
- MUST be in grades 10 through 12 during the following school year
- MUST maintain a GPA of 3.0 or better - show march grade sheet
- MUST HAVE served on DCMYC one year
- Must attend all Executive board meetings
- Preference will be given to seniors for position of Youth Mayor
- Applications are for one-year positions only

Applicants will be required to attend an interview with the Executive Advisory Board. Please be prepared to give a three minute explanation as to why you would be a valuable candidate on the board and be prepared to answer questions from the Executive Advisory Board members.

Please attach a resume to this application along with a cover letter stating in 2-3 paragraphs why you would like to be considered for leadership and your preferred position.

Address the following:

1. How will your involvement in a leadership position benefit others?
2. Given the opportunity, what single action will you take to improve the Youth Council?
3. What makes you the best person for this position?

- Your proven efforts to reach out and include others on the youth council
- Your proven ability to see a need and serve without supervision
