

Draper Youth Council Commitments and Expectations for 2019-2020

1. The DYC calendar is from July to June.
2. Activity hours are earned through participation in activities listed on the DYC calendar only. Service hours earned through outside organizations will not apply (Scouts, NHS, Youthlink, etc.)
3. 12 calendar activity hours are required to attend Legislative Day.
4. 15 calendar activity hours are required to be able to attend the Senior Award Night at the end of the year (May 2019).
5. 15 calendar activity hours are required to receive a senior award (for those in 12th grade).
6. 15 calendar activity hours are required to attend the Leadership Conference.
7. 16 calendar activity hours are required to return to the Draper Youth Council next year.
8. You must sign in & out of all activities in order to receive credit.
9. **You must do 3 of the 4 city events to return next year (Kids parade, Haunted Hollow, Tree lighting, Easter Egg)**
10. If we have to limit the number of youth attending a special event (such as Legislative Day, Leadership Conference, etc.), those with the most DYC activity hours will be selected first.
11. Please send a text to your committee leader or Caroline Sagae if you will not be able to attend an activity.

13. Please consider opening a gmail account to receive emails and google sign-ups.
14. You must serve on the Draper Youth Council for at least one year to be eligible to apply for an executive position the following year.
