



YOUTH CODE OF CONDUCT

Youth participants in Draper City Programs are expected to adhere to a set of behavioral standards that help ensure the well-being of all.

1. Be fully engaged with a positive attitude and creative energy.
2. Be courteous to and encourage others.
3. Be cooperative, help others and support teamwork.
4. Be willing to ask an adult for guidance to make good decisions and take appropriate actions.
5. Use language (verbal and non-verbal) that is respectful to others. (Swearing, harassment of any form, and bullying are not allowed).
6. Take care of the property. Assume responsibility for any intentional damage.
7. Wear appropriate clothing for activities. Follow the specific dress code, if provided.
8. Be present and on time for all parts of the program. Notify the appropriate advisor about health or scheduling issues.
9. Use technology during free time (not during NYC) and in ways that contribute to the goals of the program.
10. Do not engage in personal displays of affection. (It is distracting and inappropriate).
11. Know and follow Federal and State Laws that apply. (No use of tobacco, alcohol, illicit drugs, fireworks or firearms).

Responsibility for Addressing and Reporting Improper Conduct

Any suspicion, observation, or experience of any conduct deemed improper by a youth or adult should immediately be reported to the highest city authority present for investigation and evaluation.

Volunteers will be free from any kind of harassment. If a volunteer feels like he/she has been harassed in any way please contact Draper City Staff Liaison or the Human Resources Department right away. Harassment includes, but is not limited to, unwelcome sexual advances, request for sexual favors, and other verbal or physical conduct deemed unwelcome.

Verification and Signature

I understand that if I violate any part of this agreement, I may be sent home from any venue at the expense of my parent(s) or guardian(s). I also understand that if I cause personal or public safety concerns, I may lose my eligibility to participate in some future events and/or lose my participation privileges.
